

## INFORMATION TO HELP YOU VOTE IN THE

# 2018 Ontario provincial election

**The election for members of the Ontario Provincial Parliament is happening on June 7, 2018.**

Voting in an election is one of the very important rights and obligations of citizenship. It is an opportunity to have your say in who will be part of the government.

We hope that everyone is paying attention to what is being said by the people who are running to be part of the government and is thinking about who they feel would do the best job. We encourage you to go out and vote for the person that you would like to represent you in the government.

This page will connect you to information about how to vote and what to do if you need support or accommodations in order to take part in the process.

**Everyone, including you,** is allowed to vote if you are:

- 18 years of age or older, and
- a Canadian citizen, and
- a resident of Ontario

Voters must register to vote by having their name and address added to the voting list. This is much easier to do before Election Day. The information below will help you to make sure you are registered.
